

Information pursuant to the Digital Services Act

Business company **Asteria GRP**, registered seat: 23 Boulevard Plaza Tower 2, Dubai, United Arab Emirates, reg. no.: 1073325 (hereinafter referred to as the “**Company**”), hereby provides the following information in accordance with Regulation (EU) (EU) 2022/2065 of October 19, 2022, on the Digital Services Single Market and amending Directive 2000/31/EC (Digital Services Act) (hereinafter referred to as the “**Digital Services Act**”), fulfills its obligations as a provider of intermediary services as follows:

The competent authorities of the Member State for which the legal representative is designated, the European Commission, and the European Digital Services Board are authorized to contact the Company's legal representative regarding all matters necessary for the adoption, compliance with, and enforcement of decisions issued in connection with the Digital Services Act.

By publishing the above information, the Company has fulfilled its obligation under Article 14, paragraph 4, of the Digital Services Act, specifically ensuring that information regarding the designation of the legal representative and information about the legal representative are publicly available, easily accessible, accurate, and up-to-date.

At the same time, the Company has provided this information to the Czech Telecommunication Authority (Český komunikační úřad), with its registered office at Sokolovská 58/219 Vysočany 19000 Praha 9, Czech Republic, which performs the duties of a digital services coordinator under the Digital Services Act, the company shall notify the name, mailing address, email address, and telephone number of its legal representative.
